Frequently asked questions about the dashboard

→ What information is provided on the dashboard?

The dashboard shows trends over time for:

- Average winegrape prices at the weighbridge
- Tonnes crushed
- · Average value of wine exported from Australia
- Global bulk wine prices
- · Stock-to-sales ratios for Australian wine
- Global wine production and consumption

There are also general statistics relevant to consumer spending that can affect wine sales.

- → How does the dashboard help me with decision-making for next vintage?

 Understanding what's happening in Australia and globally regarding supply and demand for wine and grapes helps you assess the market for your grapes, evaluate price offers and make decisions regarding investments for the season.
- → Can I get a grape price forecast from the dashboard? The dashboard does not provide an actual price forecast, but gives an indication of the expected direction for prices in the next vintage, based on the trends for the key indicators.
- → Is there a cost for using the dashboard information? There is no charge for accessing the dashboard. It was developed with grant funds provided by the Federal Government to improve market transparency for Australian grapegrowers in the inland regions.



What is the Grape Price Indicators Dashboard?

The Wine Australia Grape Price Indicators Dashboard is a free online tool that provides a current summary of the key drivers of winegrape prices in Australian inland regions, as well as an indication of the expected direction for grape prices ahead of the next vintage.




The dashboard allows you to view the indicators by grape colour or variety, so you can customise the information to be more relevant to you.

What does it all mean for prices?



An arrow on the summary page shows the overall direction of grape prices for the next vintage, based on the key indicators. It is a high-level indication that applies across all inland regions and is intended to be used as a general guide only.
